


## PROGRAM INTRODUCTION

- Culinary Experiences: Learn the art of chocolate making and savor the delicious local cuisine, offering a true taste of Bali.








### PROGRAM SCHEDULE





# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

• What are the arrival and departure dates for the program?

The participants are expected to arrive at August 3rd, 2025 and will depart at August 12th, 2025.

Does the "Local Transport" on the flyer include pick-up and drop-off services at Denpasar International Airport? If so, what time will they be available?

Yes, pick up and drop off services are included at the local transport. There will be three times of pick up and drop of services, they are at 8 am, 12 pm and 4 pm.

• Which hotel will the participants stay in? If the hotel name has been confirmed, could you tell me?

The participants will stay at Quest Hotel in Denpasar City, near to Udayana University Sudirman Campus.

• Will 2 or 3 participants share a room at the hotel under the single-gender policy?

Two participants under the single gender will stay in one room.

 Although the flyer mentions a welcome dinner and lunch, will the program fee include other daily meals? Or will participants need to have them at cafeterias or purchase them from convenience stores at their own expense?

The program will dinner at day-1, day-6 and day-7, lunch box for all participants everyday (except the arrival and departure day). Breakfast will be served at the hotel.





• Does the program have a limit on the number of participants from each university?

The answer will be depended on whether you would like to have an exclusive program only for your students, or it is OK for you if we have several other universities joining the program. We are very flexible on the arrangement. If you would like to have an exclusive program only for your students, then the program will be conducted when there is a minimum of 15 students in total participating the program. However, if various university also joining, there is no requirement regarding the number of each university students participating the program. As long as the minimum number of 30 participants is achieved then the program can be conducted.

• Will participants apply for the program through a Google Form? If so, could you tell me its URL? Or will you provide us with an application form in a Word file or PDF file later?
